INTUG european court of justice

- ruling on the use by the Italian governments of its golden share in Telecom Italia
- constrains governments in their use of such shares
- similar points made by European Parliament

INTUG 1999 Review

- Lisbon summit (23-24 March)
- working documents (30? April)
- public hearing (10-11 May)
- comments by 19 May
- debate in European Parliament
- lots of lobbying
- Commission will be approve in June
- French Presidency takes over in July

INTUG ex ante regulation

- new definition of SMP, aligned with competition law
- no idea if it includes any/all GSM or UMTS operators
- unclear on joint dominance
- what is an "emerging" market:
 - UMTS?
 - WAP?
 - unbundled local loop?

INTUG public hearing

- people stating the obvious
- usual whining and special pleading
- long debate on new SMP
 - could mobile escape regulation?
- strong objection to
 - mobile number portability
 - carrier (pre-)selection

INTUG location information

- 112 European emergency number
- obligation to pass location
- could be expensive
- also an issue for fixed networks,
 complex private networks will have to
 pass the same information
- industry group meeting in Brussels on 30 June

INTUG European Parliament

- report by Wim van Velzen MEP (NL)
- strongly opposed to auctions
- recognises high prices for
 - international roaming
 - fixed-to-mobile
 - mobile-to-fixed
- excellent on consumer protection
- too strong on competition law and sunset clauses

INTUG EP also has reports on

- Fifth Report on Regulatory Implementation
- Consultation exercise on the Spectrum Green Paper
- Digital broadcasting

INTUG autumn 2000

- Commission will clear five Directives in June
- European Parliament and Council of ministers to discuss the Directives
- will end up in conciliation procedure (but when?)
- Commission will approve Spectrum Directive in September

INTUG DG Competition

- 27 July 1999 inquiries under Articles 81, 82 and 86 of EC Treaty:
 - leased lines (preliminary results)
 - international roaming (continuing)
 - local access (suspended)
- still working on data
- competition law requires solid evidence the "smoking gun"

INTUG mergers and acquisitions

- Vodafone and BellSouth as Verizon
- BT and Esat Digifone
- Mannesmann and Orange
- Vodafone and Mannesmann
- France Telecom? and Orange

INTUG vodafone + mannesmann

- first recognition of a pan-European mobile market
- MVNO access to Vodafone network for three years
- rapid disposal of Orange plc
 - UK
 - Belgium
